The regular meeting of the Pulaski Sewer Board was held on the 9th of July at 4:00pm in the auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 N Jefferson Street, Pulaski, NY.

Agenda Item #1 Review and Approval of Minutes from June 11th, 2026:

Francis Taplin made a motion to approve the minutes from June 11th, 2026, Bill Noreault seconded the motion, motion carried with all in favor.

Agenda Item #2: Staff Activity Reports:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the month of June reports for the DPW and WWTP activity reports. Francis Taplin seconded the motion; motion carried with all in favor.

Agenda Item #3: Voucher and Review of Payment:

Francis Taplin made a motion to approve Sewer Fund Abstract #3 (197,327.46), Bill Noreault seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #4: Review of Treasurers Report:

Bill Noreault made a motion to table the June 2026 Treasurer report due to not being ready yet, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

5. Old Business:

A. WWTP & Sewer Project:

Jeffrey Tubolino reviewed the letter the DEC had sent him with the Sewer Board. He discussed the topics in the letter, he noted that the Freshwater Wetland shouldn't be an issue, the Floodplain and Floodways just needed confirmation from the code officer regarding this. He said he has not heard back yet from US Army Corps of Engineers regarding the Water Quality Certification and Cultural Resources would not have any effect.

Jeffrey stated that the DOT should be good and soon as the DOT signs off, he will get the easements for Laveck.

B. Other:

Mr. Ohara stopped at the meeting, stating that nothing has changed. He stated that they wanted information about when people were at their house, he requested hard copies.

6. New Business:

A. Congregational Church:

Sewer Board discussed regarding waiving the bill for the Congregational Church, after further discussion they concluded that they are unable to waive the bill.

B. 3 S Jefferson:

Sewer Board agreed to put 3 S. Jefferson to 1 unit instead of the 1.5 unit.

C. Other

Sewer Board discussed adding onto the sewer hookup form that after 60 days you will be considered active, even if they have not tapped into the sewer line yet and that sewer cannot be turned off.
