The regular meeting of the Pulaski Water Board was duly held on the 9th day of March 2026, at 6:30 PM in the Auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 Jefferson Street Pulaski, NY 13142.

Agenda Item #1 & 2: Call to Order and Public Comment

Mike Sacco called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Agenda Item #3: Approval of Minutes

Agenda Item #4: Staff Reports

Agenda Item #7: Old Business

- A. Water Main Improvement Project
 - 1. The mainline easements are mostly complete with only one property owner left.
- B. Water Meter Project
 - 1. 531 Meters have been installed.
 - 2. An updated letter to residents who have not installed their meters by August 1, 2026, will be sent to explain the penalties that will be applied to their accounts, as well as future actions such as turning off the water, if not in compliance. Joe Bryant made the motion to approve the letter with the changes above. Byran Craig seconded the motion, and it passed with all in favor.
 - 3. Future billing for metered water will be discussed more as the 2026-2027 fiscal budget is drafted.
- C. The Village received a request from AT&T to have access to visit water tank site to climb the tank and collect structural information of the structure and any appurtenances; collect measurements and photos. The work to collect this information will not affect service.
