A regular meeting of the Village Board of the Village of Pulaski, Oswego County, State of New York was held at the Village Hall on the 8th day of August, 2022 commencing at 7:00 p.m.


WHEREAS, the Village has received a grant from FEMA as part of Senator Gillibrand's CDS request for FY2022, and has made application requesting \$1,148,146.00 for work under this grant application.

WHEREAS, CDS Grant received requires a 10% match by the Village for this funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Village Board shall proceed with the grant application process to secure \$1,148,146.00 for this work and the Village shall set aside \$114,815.00 as their 10% match required by the grant funding program, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Board shall authorize Village Mayor, Jan Tighe, to make all necessary applications and sign all necessary agreements and documents, and further authorize Village Mayor Jan Tighe, Village Clerk/Treasurer Catherine Spinney to serve as authorized representatives for grant administrative proceedings under this program.

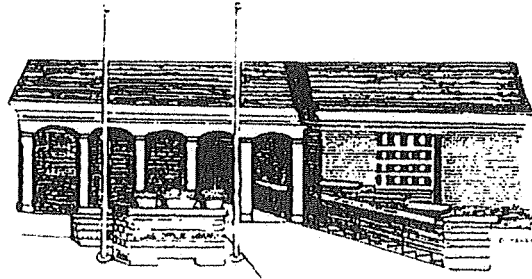
