

RESOLUTION NO. 20 OF THE YEAR 2022
AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMITTAL TO NEW YORK STATE
DEPARTMENT OF HOMES AND COMMUNITY RENEWAL

WHEREAS, the Village of Pulaski has discussed a proposed request for state funding assistance from the New York State Department of Homes and Community Renewal (DHCR) in support of the Village's proposed capital project relating to improvements to 4817-19 Salina Street (Project) and the intent to submit an application for the same to the DHCR New York Main Street Program (Funding Application); and

WHEREAS, in this regard the Village Attorney having prepared, and reviewed with the Village Board, the Short Form SEQRA EAF (EAF)

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon further discussion, and review of the EAF, Part 1, it is determined that the Project and actions contemplated in the resolution herein comprise either of a Type II pursuant to New York State Environmental Quality Review Act; as a Type II Action of the Board of Trustees has reviewed the EAF and hereby elects to act as Lead Agency, conduct an Uncoordinated Review and base upon its review of Part I & Part II of the EAF, hereby determines that same will have no significant environmental impact and this issues a Negative Declaration pursuant to New York State Environmental Quality Review Act; and it is further

RESOLVED, RATIFIED AND CONFIRMED, that as prosed and reviewed, Parts I and II of the EAF, are hereby adopted by the Village Board of Trustees; and it is further

RESOLVED, RATIFIED AND CONFIRMED, that the Village Board of Trustees shall submit the Funding Application for the Project with the total estimated minimum project cost of \$666, 667.00 in funding for the project. A maximum of \$500,000.00 proposed to be provided through the DHCR for building renovations and the property owner of the building involved has committed a minimum of \$166,667.00 (25% of total award for building renovations) in matching funds; and it is further

RESOLVED, RATIFIED AND CONFIRMED, that the Village Board of Trustees authorizes an in-kind contribution in personnel time, as needed (a minimum of \$1,500.00), related to the administrative oversight of the Project; and it is further

RESOLVED, RATIFIED AND CONFIRMED, that the Village Mayor is hereby authorized to formulate and submit such Funding Application in the form or forms presented to the Board of Trustees; and it is further


