The regular meeting of the Pulaski Sewer Board was held on the 13th of August at 4:00pm in the auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 N Jefferson Street, Pulaski, NY.

Agenda Item #1: Review and Approval of Minutes from July 9th, 2026:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the minutes from July 9th, 2026, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #2: Staff Activity Reports:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the DPW and WWTP activity reports. George stated within the report that on August 10th Scriba Electric completed the River Street Pump Transfer switch replacement and the new transfer switch was online at 3pm. They performed all the preventative maintenance tasks for the month of July. The wastewater treatment plant is operating in full compliance with the SPDES permit. The Sewer Board accepted a bid from Stark Tech for transfer switch. Bill Noreault made a motion to accept the Stark Tech bid for the transfer switch in the amount of \$15,805.00, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried. Bill Noreault made a motion to approve June 2026 & July 2026, Sewer Fund treasurers report and June 2026 and July 2026, Wastewater treasurers report. Francis Taplin seconded the motion; motion carried with all in favor.

Agenda Item #5: Old Business:

a. WWTP & Sewer Project:

Jeffrey Tubolino stated he got verbal from all the entities; he stated that they won't give approval until there are bid documents. He will give a list of easements to Cathy. He discussed with sewer board regarding having tentative date for bid opening be on 10/8/2026 at the sewer board meeting.

He noted that they are still waiting to hear on the engineering grant, it might not be until early November or December.

b. Other

Rick O'Hara stated that he did not have anything to report. Jeffrey Tubolino gave Rick the documents listing when he was at their house. Sewer Board was fine with giving Rick the information.
