

Water Board Meeting

July 13, 2026

The regular meeting of the Pulaski Water Board was duly held on the 13th day of July 2026, at 6:30 PM in the Auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 Jefferson Street Pulaski, NY 13142.

Agenda Item #1 & 2: Call to Order and Public Comment
