The Public Hearing on the Draft of the Zoning Ordinance for Cannabis Sales:

Agenda Item #2: Resolutions for C2AE Storm Water Improvements

- A. Alan Engelbrekt made the motion to approve the Resolution Setting Status under SEQR and Assuming Lead Agency Status with condition that date be changed to the date the Village Board prepares the Full Environmental Assessment Form. Ryan McGrath seconded the motion and it passed 5 -0.
- B. The motion to adopt the Resolution Authorizing Local Match for Storm Water Improvements Project was made by Alan Engelbrekt and seconded by Jack Jennings. The motion passed unanimously.
- C. The motion to approve the Resolution Designating Authorized Representative for Project was made by Jack Jennings and seconded by Robin Ford. The motion passed with all in favor.

D. Robin Ford made the motion to adopt the Resolution Setting Status Under SEQR for the Village of Pulaski Storm Water Study. Alan Engelbrekt seconded the motion and it passed 5-0.

Agenda Item #3: Review of Budget 2022-2023

The Board reviewed the budget line by line and decided that they required more information on Real Property Taxes, which will be submitted to the Board before the next budget workshop proposed for the following week. The individual Board members agreed that increases in services and/or taxes may be necessary in the final proposed budget 2022-2023.

The Board had a brief discussion regarding the Draft Cannabis Zoning Law and decided to do some further research and mark up the questions and changes they would like to see and then revisit the Draft at the next regular Village Board Meeting May 9, 2022.
