Agenda Item #1: Review and Approval of the Minutes March 12, 2026:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the minutes from March 12, 2026, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #2: Staff Activity Reports (DPW & WWTP):

Francis Taplin made a motion to approve the DPW and WWTP staff activity reports. Jasin with OMI stated that Tanner Construction was on site on 3/24/26 and was on site to begin sidewall project on sludge bay, through out 3/28/26-3/30/26 Tanner Construction on site and sidewalls were completed. The wastewater treatment plant is operating in full compliance with the SPDES permit. Bill Noreault seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #3: Voucher and Review of Payment:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve Sewer Fund abstract #10 in the amount of \$157,156.27, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #4: Review and Approval of Treasurers Report:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the March 2026 Sewer Fund treasurer report and Wastewater Improvement Project for March 2026. Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #5 Old Business:

a. WWTP & Sewer Project:

Jeffrey stated that in June they are looking to start the Laveck Storm Sewer, he is looking to be under construction by mid-June. Jeffrey stated that they still need to get easements and right away, but he stated that he must get together with Cathy for that. Jeffrey stated that they will not need a lot of easements.

b. Other:

Sewer Board discussed cleaning of the manholes. Jeffrey Tubolino stated that he went to Laveck Drive and tried to camera towards the pump station and found a grease wall in there. Jeffrey stated that he tried to get the manhole open that's at the intersection of Bridge Street and Church Street, and several others tried as well to open the manhole but were unsuccessful.

Jeffrey stated that he had spoken with Mr. O'Hara via the phone just before the meeting today. Jeffrey stated that he asked them to send him a video of the toilet and picture of the weather station along with the time and date when the issue occurs, which will help correlate the time of flow, he said more info the better. He stated that when he spoke with Mr. Ohara on the phone, he wanted to know that when they experienced the "bidet effect", if that would cause an issue with their pipes in the house, Sewer Board stated that it would not.

Agenda Item #6 New Business:

a. Purposed Budget:

Sewer Board discussed the sewer budget. The Sewer Board is purposing a 5% increase in sewer rent; Cathy will propose this increase to the Village Board.
