Village of Pulaski Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023

May 23, 2022

The Special meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was duly held on the 23rd of May 2022, in the Auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 North Jefferson Street, Pulaski, NY 13142.

Members Present: Jan Tighe, Mayor; Alan Engelbrekt, Deputy Mayor; and Robin Ford, Trustee.

Absent: Jack Jennings, Trustee; Ryan McGrath, Trustee.

Village Staff/Officials in Attendance: Cathy Spiney Village Clerk/Treasurer; and Jennifer Gibbs, Part-time Clerk.

Guest(s): Mike Sacco of the Village Water Board

The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM with Mayor Jan Tighe leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Agenda Items #1 & 2: Public Comment: There was no public comment on either the Comprehensive Plan or the 2022-2023 Village Budget.

Agenda Item #3: Approval of Vouchers

Robin Ford made the motion to approve payment of the final vouchers for the fiscal year 2021-2022. Alan Engelbrekt seconded the motion and it passed with all in favor.

Agenda Item #4: Approve Comprehensive Plan Changes

The motion to accept the changes to the Village of Pulaski's Comprehensive Plan was made by Robin Ford and seconded by Alan Engelbrekt. The motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Item #5: Final Review & Adoption of Budget

The Board completed the final review of the 2022-2023 and made the following decisions:

- The water rents will increase by approximately 5%.
- Sewer rents will increase by 2.8%.
- Trash stickers will go up \$0.50 to \$3.00 per sticker.
- The tax increase will be approximately 2%.

Alan Engelbrekt made the motion to adopt the 2022-2023 budget as reviewed. Robin Ford seconded the motion. The motion passed with Jan Tighe, Alan Engelbrekt, and Robin Ford voting in favor. Trustees Ryan McGrath and Jack Jennings were absent.

Agenda Item #6: Old Business

- A. Robin Ford made the motion to approve the purchase of two trucks, one for the Police Dept. and one for the DPW and apply for the grant application to the USDA. The motion was seconded by Alan Engelbrekt and passed 3-0.
- B. Alan Engelbrekt made the motion to approve the purchase of a Hyundai HL940A Wheel Front Loader for the DPW. The motion was seconded by Robin Ford and passed unanimously.
- C. Mayor Jan Tighe briefly reviewed the status of the Village projects and grant applications in progress.

Agenda Item #7: New Business

Robin Ford made the motion to appoint Jennifer Gibbs to the position of Deputy Clerk. Alan Engelbrekt seconded the motion and it passed 3-0.

Agenda Item #10: Adjournment:

The motion to adjourn was made by Robin Ford and seconded by Alan Engelbrekt. The motion passed unanimously.
