Agenda Items #1: Call to Order & Public Comment

The Meeting was called to order at 5:17 PM with Mayor Jan Tighe leading the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

There was no Public Comment.

Jan Tighe made the motion to welcome Jeffrey Fowler to replace Jack Jennings on the Village Board. Scott Pello seconded the motion and it passed with all in favor.

Agenda Items #2

Jeffrey Fowler made the motion to reverse the decision made at the Special Village Board meeting on December 20, 2022, and to have Joshua Smith continue his employment as Zoning Officer for the Village of Pulaski.
