

Sewer Board

June 11, 2026

The regular meeting of the Pulaski Sewer Board was held on the 11th of June at 4:00pm in the auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 N Jefferson Street, Pulaski, NY.

Agenda Item #1 Review and Approval of Minutes from May 14th, 2026:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the minutes from May 14, 2026, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried with all in favor.

Agenda Item #2: Staff Activity Reports:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the DPW and WWTP activity reports. Jasin stated that Trump's bid went up from \$20,000 to \$30,000 after adjusting the material, the Correra quote was \$35,000, Top Notch \$37,000. Bill Noreault made a motion to accept Trumps bid for the roofing, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried. Jasin stated that there was a problem with UPS, which is an emergency power service with Trojan, got quote which was \$2,700, which he did order. He is trying to see if it is under warranty. One of the valves broke for the belt press, he had Superior Drain come and give quote for replacing all 3 valves, it is about \$1,473.75. Sewer Board was fine with accepting that quote.

He said that DEC came down and did inspection, the only thing they asked for was them to file a paper called, "Water Treatment Chemical Form", for the Polymer that they use. They want him to get in touch with manufacturers of the Polymer to list the ingredients of the chemical, to make sure that it is not toxic to the fish, Jasin stated that it is not toxic.

He also is getting a quote for concrete, as the bay area does not drain the way he wants it too. He said he would bring the quotes next month. Francis Taplin seconded the motion; motion carried with all in favor.

Agenda Item #3: Voucher and Review of Payment:

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve abstract #13 for Wastewater improvement project in the amount of \$5,495.40, Sewer Fund abstract #13 in the amount of \$21,560.57 and

Sewer Fund abstract #1 in the amount of \$34,492.20, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

Agenda Item #4: Review of Treasurers Report:

Francis Taplin made a motion to approve May 2026 Sewer Fund and Wastewater Improvement Project treasurers report, Bill Noreault seconded the motion, motion carried.

5. Old Business:

A. WWTP & Sewer Project:

Jeffrey Tubolino discussed aspects of the EPA grant and submitted the grant today.

B. Other:

Mrs. O'Hara stated that she can't keep videoing as it is hard to do. They stated that they are going to keep coming to the meetings just in case there is ever a problem.

6. New Business:

A. Congregational Church:

Mr. Vanderheide discussed with the sewer board regarding the sewer bill for the congregation church. Mr. Vanderheide stated that they should be closing on the sale of the church within the next few weeks. The Sewer Board has decided to table this matter by the next monthly meeting.
