The regular meeting of the Pulaski Sewer Board was held on the 12<sup>th</sup> of March at 4:00pm, in the auditorium of the Snow Memorial Building, 4917 N Jefferson Street, Pulaski, NY.

### **Agenda Item #1: Review and Approval of the Minutes February 12, 2026:**

Francis Taplin made a motion to approve the minutes from February 12, 2026, Bill Noreault seconded the motion. Motion carried with all in favor.

### **Agenda Item #2: Staff Activity Reports (DPW & WWTP):**

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve the DPW & WWTP staff activity reports. Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

### **Agenda Item #3: Voucher and Review of Payment:**

Francis Taplin made a motion to approve the Sewer Fund abstract #9 in the amount of \$29,321.34, Sewer Fund abstract #10 in the amount of \$114,580.78, and Wastewater Improvement Project abstract #10 in the amount of \$2,254.50. Bill Noreault seconded the motion, motion carried with all in favor.

### **Agenda Item #4: Review and Approval of Treasurers report:**

Bill Noreault made a motion to approve February's Sewer Fund and Wastewater Improvement Projects treasurers report, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried with all in favor.

### **Agenda Item #5: Old Business**

#### **a. WWTP & Sewer Project:**

Dean stated that they will do the side walls first as a capital project for the 2025-2026, then during next budget season, they will budget to get the roof done. Jasin presented bids from A+ Concrete, Top Notch Roofing and Tanner Brother LLC regarding the side walls. Bill made a motion to accept the bid from Tanner Brother

LLC, in the amount of \$10,815.54, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried with all in favor. Jeffrey Tubolino stated that there is a grant that will be available, The Wastewater Infrastructure Engineering Planning Grant which is due by June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Jeffrey stated that Cedarwood Engineering can apply on behalf of the Village of Pulaski, if the sewer board wanted. Francis Taplin made a motion to allow Cedarwood Engineering to apply for the Wastewater Infrastructure Engineering Planning Grant, Bill Noreault seconded the motion, motion carried.

**Other:**

The Sewer Board discussed the ongoing matter at 32 Bridge Street and determined that another televised inspection will be conducted. Bill Noreault made a motion to authorize Steve Grim, with Rural Water to come and televise for \$300, Francis Taplin seconded the motion, motion carried.

**a. Springbrook Apartments Sewer Late Fee:**

After discussion, The Sewer Board decided that they will not waive the late fee for Springbrook Apartments. Cathy Spinney stated that she will reach out and inform the Apartments of their decision.
